

Early Years Cocoon CIC (EYC) is an organisation whose activities and services are aimed at benefiting and supporting the community, specifically families with young children in Barking and Dagenham.



We became a CIC in June 2020. Prior to this, we operated as a community group, providing most services on a voluntary basis. Despite being a young organisation, we are highly passionate about what we do and dedicated to making a positive impact in society.

## Our objectives are

- Developing supportive services for families with young children
- Promoting positive parenting by focusing on the learning and development of children
- Strengthening social, communication and artistic skills in young children and their parents
- Sharing creative and educational practice to ensure the well-being of children within supportive families
- Creating multidisciplinary stimuli for children by collaborating with other local community organisations and individuals

Our projects are continually inspired by the needs and insights of our community. We gather this information through various means, including conversations, notice boards, surveys, chats and our registration form. This community-led approach lies at the heart of what we do as it enables us to adapt and build upon the reality of the families we serve. We recognize the significant impact to the way we facilitate our services of listening to the voices of our families who often lack opportunities to express themselves.

We receive support from grants, donations and the incredible collaborations we have established since we started.

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## Our community

Our families come from diverse backgrounds with almost half identifying as belonging to an ethnic minority. Many of them face challenges such as isolation, financial constraints, lack of confidence due to language barriers, and feeling overwhelmed with parenting responsibilities. We are dedicated to supporting these families through community integration.

Based on our annual review (Dec 2022) and the data collected through our registration form, we have discovered the following insights:

- Families are motivated to join Cocoon to develop social and communication skills, connect with other parents, engage in learning opportunities, and foster a sense of community.
- Approximately 40% of families prefer not to disclose their annual household income, while over 25% report an income below £25k.
- All families have expressed that they have benefited from participating in our supportive services.
- Families are facing financial challenges due to the high cost of living, with 40% stating that they would find it difficult to pay fees for sessions if they were not offered for free.
- The top 5 activities that families enjoy the most are: free play, singing time, story-time, crafts, and interacting with other parents.
- Families have expressed their desire to have educational trips, outdoor learning opportunities, attend performances, participate in parenting workshops, and have more sessions available on weekends.







Our services prioritize early intervention, with the goal of offering young children a better and healthier start in the borough. It is evident that there is a significant demand for free or low-cost services for families, and our own observations and research have identified a gap in this area. EYC is committed to bridging this gap. We are proud to report that all our activities, events, and projects consistently bring families together, with high levels of participation and attendance.



- Growing as a team: we now have 3 facilitators and 4 support team members.
- Significant grant secured from the National Lottery a major milestone.
- Successful Toys Appeal for the third time, resulting in the donation and distribution of 200 toys.
- Collaborations established with numerous local organizations and services.
- Utilizing WhatsApp to communicate with over 400 local families, facilitating the sharing of local services.
- Families were engaged in physical activities such as games, fitness, and yoga through our "Ready, steady, go!" programme: a 12-week initiative.
- Developed a mental health handout, providing strategies and information on available services.
- Collaborated with Talk Space to offer counselling services for families.
- Co-created a booklet with 10 families and 10 organizations, covering relevant parenting topics and funded by NCIL.
- Successfully organized and facilitated one year of free yoga sessions for local residents, supported by Awards for All funding.
- Participated in outdoor and forest school activities in collaboration with Tinder Sticks and Park Rangers.
- Engaged in singing traditional English nursery rhymes as part of a heritagefocused project.
- Organized workshops delivered by artists and specialists for our families.
